



A survivor contacted the DVIC hotline regarding domestic violence involving her daughter's father. He threatened her and her other children that were not biologically related to him, alongside physical and verbal abuse. He even brandished a weapon.

DVIC admitted the family to shelter. During a funeral trip, the abuser shot at her car, causing it to be totaled. Charges were filed, and upon return to the shelter, advocates aided her in acquiring a replacement car. The survivor ensured her children's schooling and daycare, maintained her remote job, secured housing, furniture, and necessities. The family smoothly progressed to their next life phase.
